Santa Barbara Castle

One of the largest medieval fortresses in Europe. Covers the complete summit of the Benacantil Mountain. Originally built by the Moors in the 10th century.




Archaeology Museum (MARQ)

Displays its collection in a traditional way; as a collection of classified and catalogued finds. MARQ is the first archaeological museum of the 21st century.
